Course Description

This course is designed to provide the progressive care healthcare provider with a review of AACN's core curriculum, as of November 2023. This review is not an introduction to the environment of the progressive care area, but a comprehensive update for the professional already in practice at the progressive care bedside and preparing for the PCCN Certification Examination.
