<i>*Identify a patient who is due for a medication or blood product administration, lab draw, or tubing/fluid change</i>	
	1. Verify appropriate access and tubing/needleless device change (observe at least one): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observe appropriate access <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If not observed, interview: "What is the process for accessing a line?" • Observe tubing/needleless device (clave) change <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If not observed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> –interview: "What is the process and frequency of a tubing/clave change?" AND –documentation: "Please show me where the last clave change was documented within 96 hours."
	2. Verify CHG application, unless contraindicated: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documentation: "Please show me where the CHG application was documented in the last 24 hours." <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If contraindicated, interview: "What are the contraindications to CHG application?"
	3. Verify sterile dressing change: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observe: Dressing is clean, dry and occlusive and not expired (observe full dressing change if possible) • And interview: "What is the process and frequency of a sterile dressing change?"
	4. Verify insertion site and catheter assessed each shift <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interview: "What is the process and frequency of assessment?"
	5. Verify daily discussion of line need and functionality <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interview: "When and with who did you last discuss the line?"
	6. Verify RN can speak to techniques for minimizing line access <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interview: "What techniques can you use to minimize line access?"
Reliability Criteria - Card is GREEN if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All items are in compliance 	
Follow-Up: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give in the moment praise for keeping the patient safe. • Insert card into slot with green side showing and document compliance and opportunities on K-Card Daily Results form 	

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Reliability Criteria - Card is RED if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One or more items are non-compliant 	
Follow-Up: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give in the moment coaching and ensure RN addresses non-compliant item(s). • Insert card into slot with red side showing and document compliance and opportunities on K-Card Daily Results form
