*Identify a patient who is due for a medication or blood product administration, lab draw, or tubing/fluid

- 1. Verify appropriate access and tubing/needleless device change (observe at least one):
 - Observe appropriate access o If not observed, interview: "What is the process for accessing a line?"
 - Observe tubing/needleless device (clave) change o If not observed:
 - -interview: "What is the process and frequency of a tubing/clave change?" AND
 - -documentation: "Please show me where the last clave change was documented within 96 hours."
- 2. Verify CHG application, unless contraindicated:
 - Documentation: "Please show me where the CHG application was documented in the last 24 hours." o If contraindicated, interview: "What are the contraindications to CHG application?"
- 3. Verify sterile dressing change:
- Observe: Dressing is clean, dry and occlusive and not expired (observe full dressing change if possible)
- And interview: "What is the process and frequency of a sterile dressing change?"
- 4. Verify insertion site and catheter assessed each
- Interview: "What is the process and frequency of assessment?"
- 5. Verify daily discussion of line need and functionality
 - Interview: "When and with who did you last discuss the line?"

Reliability Criteria - Card is GREEN if:
