### BED OVERVIEW

**A Main nurse controls**

- Lockouts
- Bed movements
- Scale & bed exit
- Battery indicator

**B Bed exit side view lights (on foot bumpers)**

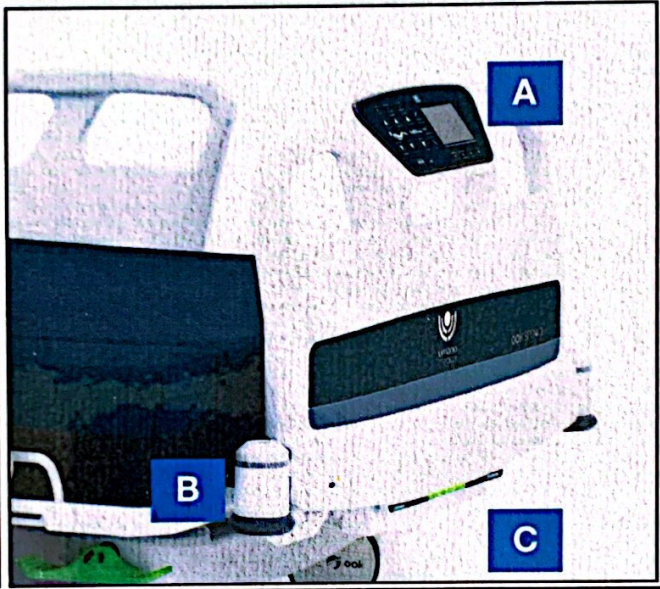
- Green = Bed exit system is armed
- Flashing amber = In alarm
- Not illuminated = System not in use

**C Bed extender**

- Reach & pull on green handle
- Pull to extend & push to retract
- Set to desired length and lock
- Install cushion

**D Infinite™ Width Expansion System**

- Pull out crank and turn to expand or to narrow patient surface (Crank will retract automatically)



**REMINDERS**

Ensure bed is plugged in to enable scale, bed exit & advanced features

Apply the brakes



**E Brake pedals**

- Push red = Brake ON
- Push green = Steer ON
- Horizontal = Neutral position (Bed is fully mobile)

**F Siderail release**


- Lift green handle UP to unlock
- Lower siderail down
- Green window indicates safe status
- Red window indicates unlocked siderail


**G CPR release handle**


- Pull red handle
- Completely lower backrest section
- Seat section will automatically retract flat.
- Press any button to cancel

SCALE & BED EXIT

 HOME button on the footboard returns the display to HOME SCREEN / MAIN MENU

 NAVIGATION buttons on footboard will activate controls

**H To arm/disarm BED EXIT system (regular/manual setting)**


① To arm BED EXIT  
Patient must be in bed to arm bed exit system.  
From HOME SCREEN  
Press "ARM" **H**  
Press "YES" (To arm bed exit)  
Verify that foot end bumper side view lights (optional) are illuminated green. When they are, bed exit system is "ARMED".

② To disarm BED EXIT (if alarm is triggered)  
Press "DISARM" (on HOME SCREEN). This will turn off the system. Patient must be placed back in bed and system must be manually rearmed.

**I To change BED EXIT detection level**  
Bed alarm must be off to make changes.

To change or set DETECTION LEVEL  
From the HOME SCREEN, Press **Patient Risk Mgmt**  
Press **Select**  
Press **→** to scroll through detection level options and press "Select detection" to select desired level.




**H To arm/disarm BED EXIT system (AUTO Arm)** 


When Auto Arm is activated and patient is detected in the bed, the bed exit is armed automatically.  
To disarm BED EXIT (if alarm is triggered) :  
Press "DISARM" (which will appear on the HOME SCREEN). This will turn off the alarm.  
If patient is out of bed :  
The system will return to stand-by mode.  
If patient is still in bed :  
The system will apply a 1-minute care PAUSE to allow the caregiver to attend to the patient. If after 1 minute the patient is still in bed, the system will automatically initiate arming procedure.

**J To ZERO the SCALE**

From HOME SCREEN  
Press "SCALE" button  
Press **→** (Press once to scroll to zero)  
Press **Select** to zero  
Press "START" to confirm  
**IMPORTANT** : Patient must not be on bed during procedure.




**I To turn ON/OFF AUTO Arm**



From HOME SCREEN, Press **Patient Risk Mgmt**   
Press "SELECT" to enter Select Detection Menu  
Press "Auto Arm" to activate or deactivate it.

**J SCALE - to weigh patient**

From HOME SCREEN, Press "SCALE"  
Press "SELECT"  
Press **Weigh** to display weight



Weight log screen informs of patient's logged weights.

**I To change ALARM settings (volume and tone)**  

Alarm must be off to change settings.  
From the HOME SCREEN  
Press "Patient Risk Mgmt"  
Press **→**  
Press "Select" to enter Alarm Settings menu  
Make desired changes and press "OK" to save changes.

**K Preference menu**  
Width management , Lights configuration, Lockouts, ID, Auto-Contour, Minimum height adjustment, Date/time, Languages and Maintenance.
