## **IABP Handover Tool**

- □IABP has at least 2 points of securement. Must be sutured proximally. Statlock permissible as distal securement.
- □IABP Size Matches Adapter Tubing
- □Operating Mode, Trigger, and Balloon Inflation (augmentation) match provider orders
- □Console plugged into red outlet and battery light indicates full charge
- ☐ Helium tubing free of blood, flecks, or condensation
- □Central lumen pressure bag is at least three feet above patient and fully inflated
- □Central lumen is transduced with 2 units/ml heparinized saline
- □Central lumen transducer is leveled and zeroed to phlebostatic axis
- □Central lumen tubing has occlusive redcaps on all ports
- □Extra length is removed from transducer tubing (maximum 8ft of tubing)
