

LACTATION ROOMS

A lactation room specifically for House Staff is located inside the House Staff Lounge which is on the 2nd floor (ground floor) of The Vanderbilt Clinic (TVC 2806). The use of the room by House Staff is on a first come, first serve basis. The space includes a privacy curtain and is equipped to accommodate one mother. There is also a clinical work-station in the lactation room so mothers may work if they choose. A refrigerator located in the dining area is designated for the storage of breast milk. The House Staff Lounge can be accessed with your ID badge at the front door. The House Staff Lounge is furnished with a small computer work-space, lounge space, dining space, restroom and kitchenette so if you need to wait for the Lactation Room you can be comfortable. This space is managed by the GME office so please let us know if you have any concerns.

Additional lactation rooms are available and supported through Human Resources with some being available only to VUMC staff and others also open to staff and patients/families.

VA lactation rooms include:

Nashville Campus: Room F – 153, ACRE Building (first floor in the building between the VA and Light Hall where resident outpatient continuity clinics are located.) This lactation room is just inside the ground floor entrance to the VA from VUMC in the hallway to the left as you enter from the outside.
