

Standardized Allergy Desensitization Order for Vanderbilt Occupational Health Clinic

The Vanderbilt Occupational Health Clinic will provide allergy injections to faculty and staff who have achieved <u>a maintenance level dose</u>. This service is provided at no charge as a convenient alternative to traveling off campus to receive these services. However, it is intended to supplement, not replace, the care of your allergist. All patients who receive allergy injections must wait for a <u>minimum of 30 minutes</u> after each visit to assure that there are no unexpected reactions or <u>OHC staff will not be able to administer your shots for you</u>.
