

## Guidance to Providers: Isolation Policy with New 2-Stage Testing for *C. difficile* Infection

All patients for whom a C. difficile test is ordered are placed on empiric Contact Precautions.

- (-) If a test for *C. difficile* is ordered, and the patient is <u>negative</u> for *C. difficile* toxin gene by <u>PCR</u> (first part of the test) and an alternative diagnosis for the diarrheal symptoms is documented by the patient's provider, then Contact Precautions may be discontinued.
- (+, -) If a test for *C. difficile* is ordered, and the patient is <u>positive</u> for *C. difficile* toxin gene by <u>PCR</u> (first part of the test), **BUT** <u>negative</u> for *C. difficile* toxin by <u>antigen</u> detection (second part of the test), the following guidelines apply for removing contact isolation precautions:
  - 1. The patient remains on contact isolation until the patient returns to his/her normal stooling pattern for minimum of 48 hours.
  - 2. Discharge or transfer from room so that all surfaces in room may be cleaned thoroughly
    - a. Patient must be bathed,
    - b. Place patient in a clean gown, and
    - c. Place patient in a clean bed if transferred to a new room
  - 3. NOTE: A negative test is NOT required (and should not performed) for removal from isolation.
- (+, +) If a patient is <u>positive</u> for *C. difficile* toxin gene by <u>PCR</u>, **AND** <u>positive</u> for *C. difficile* toxin by <u>antigen</u> detection, the patient can be removed from contact isolation per current VUMC guidelines as outlined below:
  - 1. The patient remains on contact isolation until the patient returns to his/her normal stooling pattern for minimum of 48 hours **AND**
  - 2. Patient is off of *C. difficile*-specific treatment
  - 3. Discharge or transfer from room so that all surfaces in room may be cleaned thoroughly
    - a. Patient must be bathed,
    - b. Place patient in a clean gown, and
    - c. Place patient in a clean bed if transferred to a new room
  - 4. NOTE: A negative test is NOT required (and should not performed) for removal from isolation.
