February 1-2: Imbolc

February 1: National Freedom Day — This day is internationally recognized as a day when Abraham Lincoln, who was the nation's president at the time, signed a joint resolution that proposed the 13th amendment to the United States Constitution.

February 2: Groundhog Day

February 4: Rosa Parks Day

February 6: Safer Internet Day: This day is celebrated in the second week of February to provide safer and better internet, where every user gets to use the internet responsibly and without getting their data leaked.

February 7: National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day (NBHAAD) — A day dedicated to raising awareness of the disproportionate impact of HIV on Black communities and the importance of increasing access to HIV education, testing, treatment, and prevention services.

February 10: Lunar New Year — The start of the new year on the lunar calendar, a big celebration for many East Asian cultures.

February 10: Tết (Vietnamese)
