The Vanderbilt Observational Experience (VOE for short) allows participants to shadow a Vanderbilt University Medical Center (VUMC) healthcare professional.

Participation in VOE is an opportunity to:

- explore specific healthcare roles in a clinical environment
- gain an understanding of interdisciplinary team work
- ask career-related discovery questions

VOE is for short-term observations only; hands-on activities are not permitted.

### Who can participate in VOE?

VOE is open to current VUMC Employees and Non-VUMC Employees, 16 and older.

### What are the requirements to apply to VOE?

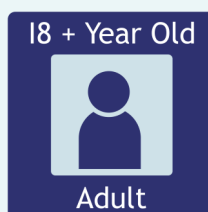
In addition to completing a VOE online application, appropriate documentation (based on age and VUMC employment status) must be provided or completed:

- Signed Confidentiality Agreement

- Upon application approval, a Background Check Application (approx. \$40 cost to participant)
