

Vanderbilt Rehabilitation Therapy

First Day Information for Students

On your first day, you will begin with student orientation to meet with your clinical instructor. During this time, you and your clinical instructor will review VUMC policies/procedures, discuss your VUMC clinical experience plans, review expectations/objectives for your clinical rotation, and begin orienting to the clinic.

Students will be scheduled for eStar (Epic) training during the first week of the clinical rotation to learn our EMR system. Prerequisites for the course are included in the Learning Exchange modules that must be completed 24 hours prior to your scheduled eStar training.

It is **strongly** recommended that students pick up their ID badge prior to their first day. If you were not able to get your ID badge prior to your first day, please work out a plan with your clinical instructor to pick up your ID badge on your first day. A scheduled appointment is required for your ID Badge.

We are located on the far **RIGHT** side of One Hundred Oaks Mall, next to Ross Dress for Less. You will see a sign for 'Vanderbilt Rehabilitation Therapy'. We are **NOT** located in the main area of Vanderbilt Health. When you arrive for orientation, you will enter the lobby and inform the front desk that you are a PT/OT student and are here for orientation with your clinical instructor. Parking:

Students may park for free at the movie theater parking lot across the street. Please **do not** park in the patient parking area directly outside of the clinic.

Parking spots designated with yellow lines are reserved for employees and you must have a parking permit for these areas.

To park in the employee designated areas at One Hundred Oaks, you have the option to purchase a parking permit. The cost for a monthly parking permit is \$16.80. You will need to register with the VUMC Parking Permit Office which can be done during the first week of your rotation or you may obtain a parking permit prior to your first day.
