

Vanderbilt Rehabilitation Therapy

First Day Information for Students

On your first day, you will begin with student orientation to meet with your clinical instructor. During this time, you and your clinical instructor will review VUMC policies/procedures, discuss your VUMC clinical experience plans, review expectations/objectives for your clinical rotation, and begin orienting to the clinic.

Students will be scheduled for eStar (Epic) training during the first week of the clinical rotation to learn our EMR system. Prerequisites for the course are included in the Learning Exchange modules that must be completed 24 hours prior to your scheduled eStar training.

It is **strongly** recommended that students pick up their ID badge prior to their first day. If you were not able to get your ID badge prior to your first day, please work out a plan with your clinical instructor to pick up your ID badge on your first day. A scheduled appointment is required for your ID Badge.

The Vanderbilt Clinic (TVC) is attached to the main hospital, directly across from central garage and next to the emergency department entrance. When you enter the building, you will go to the third floor, following signs for Plastic Surgery. Once at the front desk let them know you are an OT student and are there to meet your clinical instructor, Justin Stehr. Your clinical instructor will come out to meet you, give you a tour of the clinic, and go through student orientation. Parking for The Vanderbilt Clinic (see attached "Lot 127 Shuttle Route")

There is a free shuttle lot (Vanderbilt Lot 127) located at the corner of 8th Ave South and Chestnut Street (625 Chestnut Street, Nashville, TN). It is next to Greer Stadium and has a chain link fence around the parking lot. The Vanderbilt shuttle bus (runs approximately every 20 minutes) to main campus. From the shuttle drop off on main campus, you will walk south on Medical Center Drive to The Vanderbilt Clinic.

You also have the option to purchase a parking permit for on campus parking. If you would like to purchase a parking permit, you will have the opportunity to do so during your first week. Options and parking rates vary depending on lot availability.
