



### NEXT Eligibility Requirements

- Open to VUMC Staff & Non-Staff:
- Currently enrolled in a nursing associate, bachelor's, or pre-licensure MSN program
  - Within 12 months of graduating with an associate, bachelor, or pre-licensure MSN program
  - At least 2 completed hospital-based clinical nursing rotations
  - During program, available to work up to 36 hours per week with rotating shifts (weekends/nights/holidays)
  - Current Basic Life Support Certification from a VUMC approved agency
  - Meet VUMC employment criteria
