FELLOWSHIP	In August, we welcomed Philip Williams as our 2024/25 Colorectal Fellow. We also had the great fortune of matching Raha AlMarzooqi from the Cleveland Clinic as our 2025/26 Fellow. She will start in the summer of 2025.
GRANT	Aimal Khan and Danish Ali were awarded \$108,000 grant from FujiFilm for their Investigator Initiated Study on the "Objective measurement and Impact of mucosal oxygen tension on anastomotic leaks"
AWARDS	Thomas Ueland led an author group that won 1st Place at the Tennessee ACS meeting with their study, "Moving beyond area indices: Unmet social needs and outcomes in a general surgical cohort.
	Daniel Habib (Mentors Aimal Khan and Alexander Hawkins) was awarded the ASCRS Medical Student Research Award for his project titled "Impact of neoadjuvant immunotherapy on postoperative complications after surgery for rectal cancer".
	The Clinical Informatics Core recognized Megan Shroder and Alexander Hawkins as the Outstanding Data Project for 2023 for their project, "Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs) in Diverticulitis." This project identified higher overall PROMs scores related to quality of life in patients who chose to pursue elective colectomy after consultation for recurrent diverticulitis.
CURRENT RESEARCH	Dr. Ford continue her work on a preoperative weight loss program for our patients suffering from morbid obesity.
	Dr. Younan is working on a project to assess decisional conflict in patients considering colectomy for diverticulitis.
	Adam Fahey is a third-year medical student working with Dr. Hawkins on "Identifying Barriers and Facilitators for De-implementation of Prescribing Antibiotics for Acute Uncomplicated Diverticulitis"
PAPERS	The group had 18 papers published in the second half of 2025. They follow on the next page.
PRESENTATIONS	The section had <i>five</i> separate research abstracts accepted for presentation at the 2025 <i>American Society of Colon & Rectal Surgeons</i> meeting. Abstracts were authored by Drs. Williams, Younan, and Ali along with multiple faculty members.
